

# International Impact of COVID-19 on the Diagnosis of Heart Disease

The COVID-19 pandemic was associated with a rapid reduction in cardiovascular diagnostic procedures across the world. Members of the BNCS and BNMS participated in this survey sponsored by the IAEA. The findings have been published: Einstein et al. J Am Coll Cardiol. 2021 Jan, 77 (2) 173–185. Additional studies are indicated to assess the impact of these reductions in diagnostic care related to COVID-19, as they raise concerns for long-term worsening of cardiovascular health outcomes from lack of timely diagnosis.
